#### **Questions for the Covenant Advisor**

**Question:** I live in a townhouse. How come I have to get permission to paint my front door from both the Village and my HOA?

**Answer:** Any time you are doing work on the exterior of your home, check to see if any changes require approval. For many exterior alterations on townhouses, approval must be granted by the Village Resident Architectural Committee and also by the homeowner's HOA.

It is the homeowner's responsibility to receive approval from Hickory Ridge, as well as from the HOA. There may also be additional requirements that must be met, e.g., from the county.

Some HOAs have adopted the Village Architecture Guidelines, but they may have additional requirements unique to their HOA.



#### **ATTENTION: Pool Updates**


## **Crime Statistics Map of Howard County**


