The Chair of the Committee will be selected by the Committee members.

To join the Election Committee, you must:

- Be a member of the Hickory Ridge Community Association, which means you must own or rent a property in the Village.
- Be able to contribute about 10 hours of your time for several meetings, Candidates Night and Election Day.
- Fill out the Volunteer Application Form and return it to the Village Manager.

Fall Leaves Quick Tip!

Cleaning up autumn leaves doesn't have to be a big chore. Turn that mound of leaves into beneficial mulch and feel good about doing your part to turn waste into a usable product that nurtures your garden and keeps nutrients out of our lakes and streams.

- Start by raking the leaves out of your shrub or flowerbeds. The object is to get all of the leaves onto a grassy or otherwise flat surface.
- Use the lawn mower to chop the leaves into smaller pieces.
- Gather up the leaf mulch and apply to your flower and shrub beds, natural areas or vegetable garden. The mulch can be applied

several times over the season but you shouldn't let the depth exceed four inches at any one time




