Call For Stories

COLUMBIA ORCHESTRA PERFORMS FREE AMERICANA SALUTE TO VETS JUNE 11

In partnership with the returning Columbia Orchestra and the combined choirs of St. Louis and St. Francis pastorate -- with guest soloists and musicians -- will hold a free musical salute to military veterans 4 p.m. Sunday, June 11, at St. Louis Church, Clarksville.

The singers and Orchestra, under the baton of Columbia Maestro Jason Love for the last time, will feature "Songs from Sea to Shining Sea" -- patriotic favorites by American composers. The star-spangled program includes "Knoxville: Summer of 1915" by Samuel Barber, "The Promise of Living" by Aaron Copeland, and "The Stars and Stripes Forever," John Philip Sousa's most beloved march. Completing the musical tribute to America is the "Battle Hymn of the Republic" by Julia Ward Howe.

Concert admission is free, no ticket is required, but in-kind donations are encouraged on concert day to benefit Baltimore Station, an innovative therapeutic residential and outpatient treatment program supporting homeless and other veterans overcoming obstacles to regain self-sufficiency. 

Housing Repair Program

Who is eligible?

- You must be a Howard County homeowner
- Own and occupy the home as your principal residence
- Can be single family, townhouse or condo
- All mortgage, property taxes, HOA/condo fees, and hazard insurance payments must be current

Loan Terms

- Maximum loan amount is \$40,000
- Interest rate shall not exceed 2%
- Maximum term is 30 years

Letter of Compliance

If you are putting your house on the market this spring, request a Letter of Compliance from the Village Office well in advance of a pending settlement date. This letter is not required, but it is a valuable tool for sellers because it verifies that your property is in compliance with the Hickory Ridge Covenants. Any covenant violations on your property become the responsibility of the new owner, so home buyers often request a Letter of Compliance from the Seller. 


