Aging Well in Columbia Advocacy Committee (Celindah Grier, village rep) The Aging Well in Columbia Advocacy Committee provides input to CA staff and its Board of Directors on the needs, interests and concerns of Columbia's mature adult residents. Members advocate for opportunities, policies and programs to better serve older adults. Members must be at least 55 years old and live on CA-assessed property. The group typically meets every other month (on the third Thursday, 2:30-4pm), but that's subject to change.

Climate Change & Sustainability Advisory Committee

For a Greener, Cleaner Columbia

We here in Columbia have a shared responsibility to protect the environment for future generations, and that's what the Climate Change & Sustainability Advisory Committee (CCSAC) is all about. This committee is looking for new members (as of 9 August)! Members must have professional experience in a relevant field, such as sustainability, environmental science, community engagement, etc. To apply, send a cover letter and resume summarizing your passion and prior experience

to <u>energy@columbiaassociation.org</u>. Drawing on their knowledge and background in the subject matter, CCSAC members support CA's efforts to address the ongoing threat of climate change. This includes advising on topics like energy efficiency, waste management and water quality. The CCSAC also works to provide education around

clean energy practices and was a critical piece of <u>a recent effort to assess climate</u> vulnerabilities throughout the community.

The CCSAC typically meets on the second Wednesday of every month from 7-8:30pm. Members also participate in sub-committee meetings on a regular basis. The next meeting is 13 September.

Columbia Aquatics Advisory Committee (CAAC)

The CAAC provides input to CA staff on aquatics policies and programs, suggesting improvements to both facilities and activities. Representing a wide range of user groups (i.e. – lap swimmers, rec swimmers, Aqua Fitness, CNSL, etc.), the CAAC also offers the Board of Directors guidance and recommendations on capital investments for desired aquatics projects
