- 8. CA Advisory Committees, an introduction
 - a. Columbia Art Center Advisory Committee
 - i. What they do: The CACAS provides input to CA staff to ensure that Columbia Art Center remains a flourishing arts resource for the community. This includes advising CA on developing and implementing new programs, events and community projects/collaborations. The CACAS is committed to increasing the community's opportunities to enjoy quality art! A mix of village representatives, art-centered representatives and department representatives serve on the committee.
 - ii. When they meet: The next meeting is 6 December at 2 pm (the website is incorrect). This committee meets quarterly.

b. Golf Advisory Committee

- i. What they do: The Columbia Golf Advisory Committee provides input to CA's staff on suggested improvements for CA's golf operations, policies and programs. Members also serve as liaisons between the golf club members and CA management, specifically regarding member concerns. The CGAC is made up of sub-committees that focus on issues like course conditions, tournaments and handicapping, and the relationship between the Turnhouse restaurant and Hobbit's Glen.
- ii. **When they meet:** Third Tuesday of February, May, August and November at 7pm

c. Teen and Middle School Advisory Committee

- i. What they do: The Teen and Middle School Advisory Committee is made up of two groups: high school (ages 13-19) and middle school (ages 11-13). These groups serve as a resource to the CA staff and the Board of Directors to ensure that the needs and interests of teenagers in Columbia are met. Members organize and implement programs and activities for their peers, gaining self-confidence, leadership experience and new friends along the way.
- ii. When they meet: Middle schoolers on the Teen and Middle School Advisory Committee meet at 6pm on the first and third Wednesdays of each month. High schoolers meet monthly, typically on the third Tuesday at 5pm.
