Clear Your Sidewalks

Howard County does not remove snow on residential sidewalks. The property owner (including townhouse and condo associations) abutting a sidewalk in a $^{\circ}$ public right-of-way is responsible for removing snow from the sidewalk within 48 hours after the snowfall. [Howard County Code, Section 18.402(h)(1)].

If a property owner hasn't removed the snow within that timeframe, you may want to contact the property owner and inform them about the County Code or ask if they need help. Residents may be physically unable to shovel snow and hesitant to request help.


