# Patuxent Commons



Patuxent Commons is a vibrant new mixed-income, affordable housing community in the Hickory Ridge Community of Columbia, MD that will foster social connection among neighbors and engagement with the wider community. It is a place where people of all ages, abilities and incomes can live, thrive, and connect.

Registration to be entered into a Housing Lottery for the initial leasing of Patuxent Commons will open AUGUST 1 and run through AUGUST 10, 2025. To register online starting AUGUST 1,

visit <a href="https://PatuxentCommons.com">https://PatuxentCommons.com</a>. The lottery drawing will take place on/around August 15<sup>th</sup> and successful applicants will be notified of their lottery number. Leasing appointments will be held by order of lottery number beginning in late August. Completing registration and receiving a lottery number do not guarantee housing. Eligibility requirements apply for some units.

Currently under construction, this 76-unit apartment will offer both affordable and market rate units when it opens this October. The community is being

developed by <u>Mission First Housing Group</u> based on an intergenerational housing concept envisioned by the <u>Autism Society of Maryland</u>. Older adults will have the opportunity to rent 40% of the units; 25% of the units (19) will be reserved for persons with disabilities. The balance of the units will be available to families and other adults seeking affordable housing options. Six units will be offered on a market rate basis.

The Autism Society of Maryland is proud to be part of this innovative and inclusive project!




#### Coral Reef Encounter July 19 & 20 Jeffers Hill Pool

#### **Housing Repair Program**

#### Who is eligible?

- You must be a Howard County homeowner
- Own and occupy the home as your principal residence
- Can be single family, townhouse or condo
- All mortgage, property taxes, HOA/condo fees, and hazard insurance payments must be current

#### **Loan Terms**

- Maximum loan amount is \$40,000
- Interest rate shall not exceed 2%
- Maximum term is 30 years

#### **Letter of Compliance**

If you are putting your house on the market, request a Letter of Compliance from the Village Office well in advance of a pending settlement date. This letter is not required, but it is a valuable tool for sellers because it verifies that your property is in compliance with the Hickory Ridge Covenants. Any covenant violations on your property become the responsibility of the new owner, so home buyers often request a Letter of Compliance from the Seller. 
