Columbia Card = DISCOUNT

If you live on CA-assessed property but aren't a CA member, you can request a free Columbia Card to access CA facilities at a reduced, pay-as-you-go rate. As a Columbia Cardholder, you'll get discounts at CA's pools, tennis courts, and golf courses, as well as on group fitness classes and kids' programs.

SUMMER BONUS: Columbia Cardholders receive 4 single-use guest passes per family on their Columbia Cardholder accounts. These guest passes are automatically added. The passes can be used at any of CA's 23 outdoor pools throughout the summer, Monday – Thursday only (excluding Holidays). They cannot be used

Please use the GREEN bin!

The GREEN bin, provided by Howard County with your tax money, is a great way to reduce/reuse/recycle. These GREEN bins are used for two major types of residential items: yard trim and food scraps. By yard trim we mean grass cuttings, leaves, twigs and branches. Food scraps include wilted flowers, vegetable and fruit skins, seeds and cores, expired or deteriorating foods or uneaten leftovers from your fridge or pantry. Yes, you CAN put meats and fish into the GREEN bin! Unfortunately, the GREEN bin is not for the plastic or styrofoam packaging your food comes with from the store, so please remove it before you toss those items in the bin. To reduce odors, feel free to wrap the scraps in paper bags, old newspaper, compostable bags or layer it with shredded paper.

Why use the GREEN bin? The collected items from the GREEN bin are used to make HoCoGro compost at Howard County's Alpha Ridge landfill. The compost takes 75 days to "mature" and can then be sold. Compost makes great fertilizer for your garden and landscape plants, and even your lawn. HoCoGro Compost is sold to Howard County residents year round at the landfill for \$24/cubic yard. HoCoGro Compost, mulch and blended topsoil are unbagged, so be sure to bring your own bags or containers unless filling a truck bed. As residents we can do better: Howard County conducted an audit of residential trash in 2022, after the GREEN bin was introduced, and found that 38% of the trash was organic waste that could have been made into compost. This was actually higher than the previous study in 2019. So think before you put those foods turning odd colors at the back of your fridge into the trash: put them in your GREEN bin! Don't have your own green bin? Contact the Howard County Bureau of Environmental Services office (410-313-6444) or [sign-up online](#) to have one delivered to your home.



A Smarter Way to Age in Place

Need a place to live, but looking to make a connection? Want a roommate, but not sure how to start?

[HoCo Home Share](#) is a free program that matches homeowners who have a room to spare with local residents seeking housing. Program staff use a smart, automated platform to identify strong potential matches based on personal profiles and preferences, then guide both parties through introductions, development of a home-sharing agreement, and the leasing process.

The program is managed by [Bridges to Housing Stability](#), a nonprofit organization that has provided housing services to Howard County residents for 35 years.

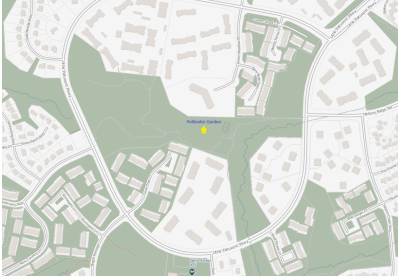

New Pollinator Meadow in Clary's Forest!



Perhaps you've heard about the decreasing number of butterflies and bees in the area? Fewer pollinators can have a negative impact on our ecosystem and food supply. Your Hickory Ridge Village (HRV) CARES Committee recently sent a HRV board-approved proposal to the Columbia Association requesting a pollinator garden in the Clary's Forest circle. The proposed area, which is currently home to invasive plants, will be replanted with native plants that will attract butterflies and bees. We also requested that the field be maintained so children will have room to play. CA approved the idea and proposed expanding it to a pollinator meadow with native trees added to the mix. While we do not have a firm time-line for completion, CA started work the week of 30 Mar removing the invasive plants and prepping the area for planting. A sign marks the area to be planted. The CARES team will track progress and report back, hopefully with pictures.

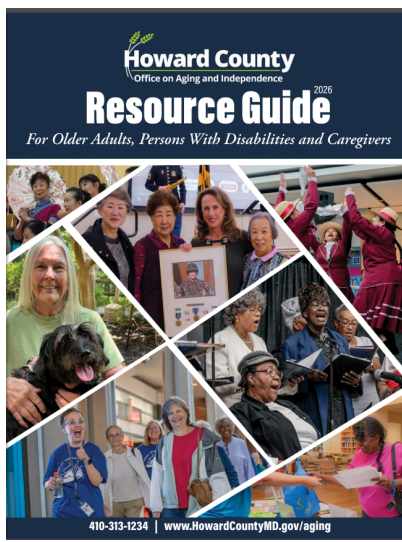

Letter of Compliance

If you are putting your house on the market, request a Letter of Compliance well in advance of a settlement date. It's best to make the request when the house is put on the market. This letter is not

required, but it is a valuable tool for sellers because it verifies that your property is in compliance with the Hickory Ridge Covenants. Any covenant violations on your property become the responsibility of the new owner, so home buyers often request a Letter of Compliance from the Seller.
