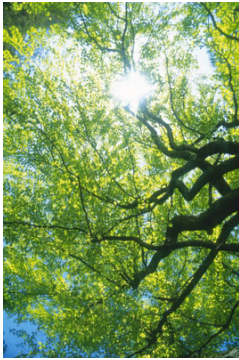

## ADOPT A TREE OR THREE

### We Need Volunteers

Many of us walk the CA pathways for exercise and to enjoy our natural habitat. For those who walk in Clemens Crossing, please be aware that Columbia Association arranged for new trees to be planted along the pathway that runs from HRBR10 to Cardinal Lane in Clemens Crossing. This grant funded project is a collaboration between Howard EcoWorks and Columbia Association. Students already worked with EcoWorks during spring break to remove invasive plants in the area. Subsequently over 50 moisture tolerant trees were planted including bald cypress, sycamore, witch hazel, black gum, and pin oak. The objective of this work was to reforest the area since multiple trees had been removed due to disease.

Now we need a few volunteers who can help maintain the trees. We would ask for two or three visits to your adopted tree/trees across the year to remove any tall grass or weeds at the tree base or invasive vines that try to creep up the wire cage and strangle the tree. ## Who Takes Care of What??

The Village office receives anonymous reports of concerns about a lot of different issues. Often, they are concerns that can be addressed by the Village, but we also get reports of issues that we cannot address.

The Village **Covenants** empower the Covenant Advisor to address problems like unmowed grass, peeling paint and bulk items in a yard. However, the Covenant Advisor is limited by the Covenants as well.

Some issues that ARE NOT included in the Covenants, which would be addressed by other agencies are:

- Pet issues (off leash, waste etc.) - [Howard County Animal Control](#)
- Trees between the sidewalk and the street - [Bureau of Highways](#)
- Street issues like pot holes or a sign down - [Bureau of Highways](#)
- Columbia Association Open Space (paths, bridges, tot lots, playgrounds) - [open.space@columbiaassociation.org](mailto:open.space@columbiaassociation.org)
- Street light outage - [BGE reporting tool](#)

Some issue are on HOA property. If you live in a townhome or condo community, your HOA would handle the following:

- parking issues
- mailbox issues
- trash or trash cans on islands/collection points
- carports
- common property of the HOA



## Columbia Card = DISCOUNT

If you live on CA-assessed property but aren't a CA member, you can request a free Columbia Card to access CA facilities at a reduced, pay-as-you-go rate. As a Columbia Cardholder, you'll get discounts at CA's pools, tennis courts, and golf courses, as well as on group fitness classes and kids' programs.

**SUMMER BONUS:** Columbia Cardholders receive 4 single-use guest passes per family on their Columbia Cardholder accounts. These guest passes are automatically added. The passes can be used at any of CA's 23 outdoor pools throughout the summer, Monday – Thursday only (excluding Holidays). They cannot be used at other Columbia Association facilities or programs.

## If A Tree Falls...

Maryland follows the Massachusetts fallen tree law, which explains who is responsible for a tree that falls on a neighbor's yard. A neighbor is not liable for a healthy tree falling down during a major storm event, even if it falls on someone else's property...On the other hand, if the neighbor's tree was diseased or decayed, was known to be at risk of falling and the neighbor ignored it, there could be negligence and liability. Either way, if you have homeowner's insurance, the insurance companies will sort out fault and blame.

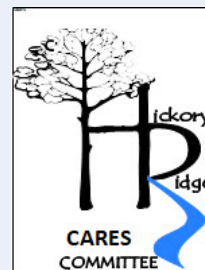

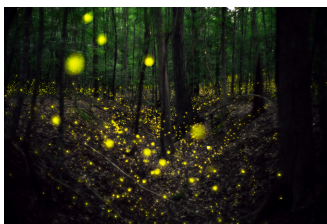

**Fireflies in the Village!**

At twilight and the evening hours, look up towards the treetops and down

to your toes, and there you will find one of summer's delights — the 'firefly,' also known as the 'lightning bug.' Its scientific name is Lampyridae, and it's a beetle, not a 'fly' or a 'bug.' Their flickering 'bioluminescence' is 'efficient' since it produces no heat, and its flashing signals are unique patterns that attract a partner. Among the over 2000 species worldwide, Maryland has about 25 different species. Fireflies deposit their eggs in moist soil or leaf litter, then survive on consuming snails, slugs and worms as larvae. After the larvae transform in the soil, they emerge as adults to reproduce, bringing joy and inspiration to the world around us.

Scientists have observed declines in the firefly population because of habitat loss, light pollution and pesticides. However, you can still attract more

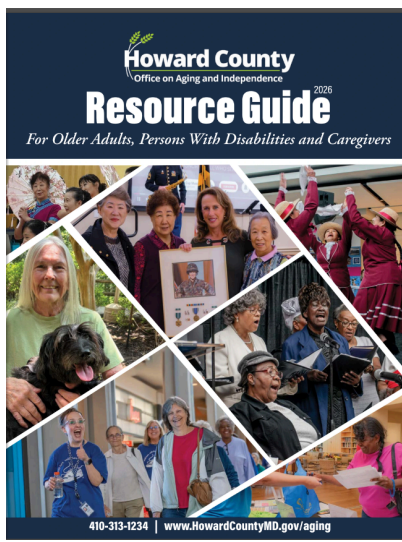

## Letter of Compliance

If you are putting your house on the market, request a Letter of Compliance well in advance of a settlement date. It's best to make the request when the house is put on the market. This letter is not required, but it is a valuable tool for sellers because it verifies that your property is in compliance with the Hickory Ridge Covenants. Any covenant violations on your property become the responsibility of the new owner, so home buyers often request a Letter of Compliance from the Seller.
